Wake up, America. Seriously? Come on. Come back to me. Wake up. I'm in an intense mood today because I have spent a week. Actually, a couple of weeks. I was out with Bobby Kennedy working on some stuff, traveling all over the country, seeing headlines that are scaring me. Are we getting through? How many people is it going to take? How many does it take to make change? How many have people have to wake up to get what's going on in this country? We are failing miserably. We are dying. We are killing ourselves off. I'm not making this up. What's got me in a rant today is a headline I saw just the other day. Here it is. "Sperm count more than halved in western men." Our sperm is declining in the Western civilization. Now, this included countries like North America, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, a 59.3% decrease in sperm. Now, they did not see this decrease in South America, Asia, Africa. Now we keep walking by headlines like this and we go on with our day. So I'm going to try and clue you in how I see the world because I need you to wake up.

Maybe I'm crazy. Maybe I'm not as awake as I think I am. But these are serious problems. If we have a 59.3% decrease in sperm in America, the greatest nation in the world, that means we're 60% on our way to being extinct people extinction. I'm not making this up. In fact, that is exactly what one of the authors of this study said. "Eventually, we may have a problem. And with reproduction in general, and it may be the extinction of the human species." Now put this on top of every one of your friends that's in IVF treatment right now trying to get pregnant. Women can't get pregnant. Men don't have any sperm. At what point do we get alarmed? At what point do we say, hold on a second, We are on the verge of pushing ourselves into extinction. This sounds like a science fiction movie. It ran through my head. In fact, there was a science fiction movie just like this. It was called Children of Men. Check out the trailer. It's an old film.

What if the most precious resource in the world show him was your only hope? She's pregnant. They want your baby. We have to leave. We're almost there. We're almost there. Children of men.

We watch these science fiction movies and we say, hey, that will never happen. That's fiction. That's Hollywood. Well, what would keep this from happening? How would we find ourselves in a place where women cannot get pregnant at all? Suddenly we cannot procreate. Is it possible? Is it possible? Is it just because writers make this up? When you see things like a 59% decrease in sperm when IVF treatments are through the roof and women can no longer get pregnant? I have so many friends that are having to adopt because they cannot get pregnant. Now. Adoption is a great thing and I don't mean to be putting anything against that, but why are we having trouble getting pregnant? What's going on? Well, this study talks about the sperm and that's what we're going to stay focused on. What are they saying or doing it? Pesticides, plastics, herbicides, smoking, stress, diet, watching too much TV. You know what they don't put in here? How about vaccines? How about vaccines? Is it possible that somehow we're messing up our auto immune systems to the point where we can no longer create sperm? We know that one of the side effects of the HPV vaccine is ovarian failure. A vaccine we are forcing girls into is causing their ovaries to fail. So they go into menopause at 12 or 13 years old. Because you think somebody is going to take care of this for you. You think there's some government, some president, some genius that is looking out for you, some FDA, some EPA looking out for you? I have news for you. They are not they are already owned by the industries that are producing all of the pesticides and chemicals that we believe are doing this. We still have BPAs in our plastic. We know it affects our sperm. You have glyphosate, endocrine disruptors, glyphosate, which is now put on the cancer list here in California. It's it's being sprayed on 80% of our crops across America. It's an endocrine disruptor, yet nobody cares. The FDA is refusing to test our food supply, even though they know this stuff's in it. And guess what? We've just discovered that glyphosate is in our vaccines. Everywhere we look, we are taking on toxins. And every time you talk about vaccines, people will say, well, it's not the vaccines, it's probably the food. Well, then let's talk about the food. They say, Well, it's probably not the food, it's probably the air.

Well, let's talk about the air. The air people say, well, it's probably not the air. It's probably the water. And then the fluoridation water, people say, yeah, it's the fluoridation of the water. And people say, are you crazy? We just keep passing the buck. One of these things is killing us. One of these things is making us sterile and we're not investigating any of them. The FDA, the EPA, nobody's doing anything for you. You are on your own. I am trying to make this clear to you. You might as well accept that you live in a world that has no FDA, has no EPA because nobody's looking out for you. The EPA has people working from Exxon on it. Fda has Monsanto employees working for them. They've been totally infiltrated. So stop thinking someone cares. You know when I realized this was true? You know when I realized that we would never find out the truth if something really, really devastating happened? I was living in New York City when 9/11 took place. I was on 46th Street, living between ninth and 10th Avenue. So I was just several blocks up, I think 40 blocks up from where the World Trade Centers were hit. And I woke up that morning just like everyone did. I was watching on the TV. Only difference between me and you if you didn't live in New York City.

As I went up onto the roof of my of my building and I looked and I saw the smoke billowing for real. Now, here's the difference between most New Yorkers and me, how I was raised. I immediately thought, what is burning in those buildings? What was on those planes? Is it possible that they had some sort of chemical warfare on there? Is it possible that they had some sort of genetic warfare? Maybe they had a virus they're releasing? I didn't know. And so my first thought was, how do I get off of this island where that smoke is burning? And I called. Phones weren't working. We couldn't get through. And every single news agency in New York City was telling us, you cannot leave the island, you cannot get off. All of the bridges are closed. All of the roads are closed. Well, eventually my mother got ahold of me from Boulder, Colorado, and she said, hey, Del, on our news here in Boulder, they're telling us if you drive north, you can drive right off the island. And I said, great, let me see what I can do. So I called, I think it was budget rental car. And I'm thinking today they are going to gouge me. I will probably pay \$1,000 to rent a van to get off of this island because as far as I'm concerned, we are under attack. Two planes have hit.

Are more coming? We don't know. I ask these questions. I don't just sit there and go, Oh, wow. Hey, two planes ran into the World Trade Centers. What else is coming? What is burning there? What questions should I be asking as an intelligent human being? So I called budget rental car and I said, What would it cost to rent a van today to drive off the island? I want to go up to Newport Beach in Connecticut or and and they said, \$50 a day. I said, \$50 a day. I'll take two vans. I'll take two vans. Right now. I'm going to call all of my friends. So I rented those two vans. I called all my friends. We were all waiting tables at the time. And you know what they said to me? Oh, gee, Del, sorry, I can't. I have a shift tonight. I got to work. You got to work? We are under attack on this island. We have two planes that have just run into the World Trade Centers. And you're not worried about what's burning up there? No, not at all. So I took off. I grabbed my my then fiancée. She had two friends visiting from Italy, which they were like, yeah, get us off of this island. And so when we drove upstate off of the island, there was two police officers standing in the middle of the street going like this, just waving.

And nobody else. You have never seen clearer roads in New York in your entire life. We drove freely right up north. I did not see maybe one other car in sight. So I have news for you. If there was biological warfare being used, we weren't going to be told, you know why? They don't want to create a panic. They don't want hysteria. On May 15th, Judge Benningfield issued this standing order. Any inmate who completes a neonatal health class then has an option. Female inmates can get a free nexplanon birth control implant in their arm. Male inmates can get a free vasectomy. They will then be given 30 days credit toward their jail time.

What I'm hoping to do is help them start thinking about taking responsibility for themselves.

So far, 32 women in the jail have gotten the birth control implant, which lasts for four years. 38 men are waiting to get vasectomies.

No, I don't know what you think about this, and frankly, I don't care. But I had this discussion. I started looking at this story. I was talking to some friends of mine and many of you know, I was, prior to running this vaccine issue, I was a devout progressive liberal. So I always wanted to make that point. That's where I'm coming from. But stories like this, I think I always take people's surprise on my take. Look it, you've got this judge. He wants to take away people's ability to procreate. If they've got a jail sentence coming their way, he'll even give them days off, 30 days off, in fact, from jail. And people are in an uproar. I'm not I don't know where you thought I'd land on this. I think this is a perfectly good idea. Why we are talking about fertility. The one thing we don't need to be doing is growing prisoners and parenting. I don't need prisoners having four and five kids when the middle class in America is reducing themselves down to 1 or 2 kids because that's all you can afford anymore. So if you either as a woman get nexplanon or you get a vasectomy, as men, you get 30 days knocked off of your sentence. This is voluntary. And if this is what people want to do, they should be allowed to do it at any time. We can curb the population growth and probably are less needed part of our society. I don't see a need for criminals in our society and I don't see a need for them having kids. And if they're willing, I would never take that away. I would never believe in forcing anyone to get a vasectomy. But this is voluntary. And this is what's so shocking. The ACLU weighs in on this, and this is what they had to say, "Offering a so-called choice between jail time and coerced contraception or sterilization is unconstitutional. Such a choice violates the fundamental constitutional right to reproductive autonomy and bodily integrity." Such a choice. They're using the word choice in their argument here. The ACLU. Seriously, don't you have better things to worry about than whether some judge wants to give people the opportunity to get out of jail if they just stop having kids? I don't understand this. And where is the ACLU, by the way, when we have states like New York that are injecting girls with HPV vaccines without parental choice, a vaccine that, as we now know, if you go on YouTube, causes infertility, causes ovarian failure.

Okay. Well, so we've been here, we're on our fifth day. We flew through immigration. So well done. Absolutely everybody who kept that that quiet flew through. And as soon as we got into the airport, we announced that we were there. And that's when we experienced the American mean Australian dark side, mean literally hundreds and hundreds of online trolls or whatever you want to call these people who just hit him with, It's not fair. How did they get into Australia? And then and then with that came the press and we've had press in the 5 days we've been here that has gone to the UK. We've had messages from all over the world of being front page headline news that the team is in Australia and how upsetting and disgraceful it is that we've been here. Health ministers, education ministers calling us loons, anti-vaccine, extremely dangerous, spreading our pseudoscience dangerous message as we travel around. I mean, it's quite unbelievable the amount of press that we've got. But I will say this Del. One thing we were not prepared for is how strong the Australian people are. They now, we're told by who organized this whole tour that these people do not normally come out.

And what they did was they made, you know, instead of telling the Vaxxed story, they made it a controversy over somehow the Australian Vaccination-skeptics network misleading the venue and saying and misrepresenting that they were showing the movie VAXXED. And so this was actually done at a at a public high school, at a at a government run high school. And the government run high school never asked what movie was being played. They never they they said literally that they did not care that we were hosting a film night. And then when VAXXED aired, all hell broke loose and the principal of the school went ballistic. It went all through the top levels of the government. It was covered in the press. There were reporters from print media, reporters on the radio, reporters on television. Asked me what city we were going to for our next showing. And, you know, of course it was really wonderful because I could honestly say I don't know where we're going. And and but she pressed the issue. She wanted to out the venue. You know, it was obvious that they, um, they have been programed with lies To think that this movie is somehow a threat and free speech is somehow a threat. You know, one of the things that people don't realize is that in Australia, if you're a medical professional and you speak out as a vaccine skeptic, as a medical professional, then you could be prosecuted criminally, you could face jail time, you could face very, very heavy fines. And from what I've heard, up to ten years of jail time, if a practitioner actually questions the safety and efficacy of vaccines. And so, you know, these people that come out, that come out to the venues that come out and tell their stories, that come out to the get togethers, they're strong.

One I was really nervous about safety, I was concerned because I say, I know we pushed the envelope of free speech here in America. I don't know how Australia works. I don't think they even have a right to free speech. So, that's one of the reasons. The other reason is there's a lot of work that's going on here that I thought you guys can cover it well, which obviously you're doing. And I could stay here and help Bobby Kennedy and other people work here in the States. But I do want to say that I was nervous about my safety. Are you nervous there? Do you feel in danger in any way?

Um, this is it's the way that that people are wherever we go. You know the trolls don't come out the trolls are sitting in their parents basements blogging. They're not coming out and they're not protesting.

I will go to my grave regretting one thing in my life that I have done that I listened to that doctor and I let her vaccinate him. I will always remember that it is the only regret I will ever have in my life. Thank you. Appreciate it.

How did that get set up And and how was the interview? I understand that this was actually they they had to take two attempts at this. Is that true?

Absolutely. So my publicist got a call and I was very surprised. And I immediately started to do my research about the person who was interviewing me. And right away I noticed he is an adult with autism. So right there, I thought that was peculiar. Someone from the neurodiversity group who has been attacking me, that group. So right away, you know, I didn't feel good. I was so nervous. I told my publicist, this is a total setup. I know it is. I'm going anyway because I wanted to reach those one, 2 or 10 people that aren't in our autism community. And maybe I can get them interested in the idea that autism is preventable and treatable. So I went in for the interview and Del I was slammed from the second this guy opened his mouth. He was attacking me. I mean, you would have thought that he was just throwing left, right jabs, one after the other. And I just tried to, you know, stay cool, try to get the information across that I was there to get across. And it was an all out half an hour.

In fact, it was it was so bad that they admitted it right? And gave you a second chance. Is that my understanding? Grabbed you a different reporter. What's her name? I think I have it here. Elizabeth. Mary Elizabeth Williams actually ended up interviewing you the second time I watched that interview. And I have to say that, when you go online, you read headlines about interviews and the headlines. Some of the headlines I saw were to the effect that, Dara Berger destroys idiot, you know, reporter at Salon and things like that. I want to say to everyone out there, I don't think that's helpful. I don't actually think that that's helpful. I actually thought that Mary Elizabeth asked some relevant questions there. The questions that come from the other side. And we have answers to those questions. And if we keep attacking people that actually give us the time and asked us questions and allow us to to make our points, then how are we ever going to grow, as you said, beyond sort of the choir of people that already know the truth about the dangers of vaccines, who have already had vaccine injuries in their families? We've got to grow. There's 95% of America that are walking blindly into this vaccine decision. And if we attack everyone that brings us on television or decides to at least make an attempt, even if they try and berate us. You were incredible in this interview. Well, basically, you know, I have a son who has autism and he has suffered a lot over the past decade. And, this book was to honor what he's been through. First and foremost, that just for him, everything he's been through to mean something. This is his legacy, this book, but twofold. It's also I did everything in my power to prevent autism and my daughter. And I was successful. And I did it with the help of all the practitioners who are in the book, all the information that's out there. And I was telling my story over and over to parents, and one day I just had an epiphany and I said, you know, I just need to do this on a larger scale because like you were talking about seeing the kids at the amusement park. Del I'm at the playground. I see the kids drooling. I see the children with helmets for seizures. And I can't take it, quite frankly. So I just wanted to put the information out there.

Okay. I think more and more people are concerned. Everybody knows everybody is seeing where more and more children are getting cancer. I mean, you can't meet a child that doesn't suffer from some sort of chronic illness. So I think people are waking up. But unfortunately, people are being taught to believe that their choices don't matter what they eat, their cleaning products, the Wi-Fi being on, you know, the glyphosate in the food, and they're very complacent until it's too late. So the idea of my book is to really let people know there's so much you can do and every choice that you make matters. And it's important to make the best choices you can every day. Because you've seen Stephanie Sanofi's that she said 1 in 2 children by 2032 is going to have autism. Well, she and I figured out for the book's sake for 2017, the year that the book has been published, what is the real rate of autism? And we figured out it's one in 11 or 12 children. So those are your chances if you're having a baby right now, 1 in 11 children.

It's amazing. People don't realize that we've essentially stopped. Even the CDC stopped calculating, I think is the last kid calculated was born in 2004 or something like, we are not tracking autism anymore. So the numbers, we don't know what they are. And I always say this, if the numbers were getting better because the CDC claims they're looking at this and working on this, don't you think they'd be posting them if we were back to 1 in 250 or moving towards 1 in 500? Don't you think somebody would be reporting that because that would be good news. They want good news on this topic and all they have is bad news and no one wants to report it. So now this book isn't just your opinion. You have how many medical professionals and advisors are actually interviewed. That's what this book is. It's a series of interviews. Tell me about that and how you put it together.

Exactly. So there's eight practitioners, a few doctors, a couple scientists, nutritionists, nurse, physician assistant. And then my personal story weaves the book together because, of course, I have a child with autism. I talk about everything that went wrong, beginning with when he was catapulted into autism, which was from a vaccine injury. At 18 months. My son suffered two ischemic strokes, but after trying to recover him for many years, I realized that a lot of the things I was doing every day were weakening his body to make him more vulnerable to the environmental assault. I mean, every single waking moment, I am researching ways to get him better and doing things. And thank God, with the help of all these doctors who are in the trenches every day trying to recover children. I did recover his speech four years ago, and he continues to make progress every day. So again, autism is treatable.

Mainstream medicine would say that autism is not treatable, that if your child hasn't spoken for the first 5 or 6 years, they're probably never going to speak. And you better just deal with that. I can't imagine. What was that moment like after all that time to finally hear your child's voice?

It was amazing because just like you said, when I went to the neurologist and he was diagnosed, I got there's no hope. No, don't look for answers. Some people find a kind of ABA therapy helpful, but there's no cure. And I went home devastated. And thank God I got myself to a functional medicine doctor right away. And she gave me all the hope in the world. So I feel so lucky.

So you essentially stopped listening to the lab coats and the stethoscope wearing idiot at your hospital, your pediatrician, and went and found people that are actually achieving healing in these children? I want to point that out. The reason why these stories are so important is if any child can be cured of autism, then it cannot be considered strictly genetic, which is about the only thing they're looking at at the CDC. I am much more afraid of an MMR shot than I am about getting the measles natural because then I have natural immunity for the rest of my life.

This is always the question. Well, what about what is your responsibility to everybody else's child? Well, let me ask you this is what I would say. Would you kill your child if it was for the good of other children in society? Would you kill them? Is this some sort of Sophie's Choice experience? Where we've decided is there is there a single reason you can imagine as a parent that you would kill your own child in order to protect other kids? Because I would not. I can't think of a single reason I would kill my own child.

But here's the problem. Vaccines will definitely, assuredly kill children this year. It is going to happen. So I think people don't understand. We can't even have an intelligent conversation with our media. I mean, you see the commercials on every newscast. Three out of five commercials are about some drug that can maim, blind or kill you. So the journalist's livelihood depend on the money that's coming from these pharmaceutical companies through ads.

Anytime a book is not written by one person with an opinion, but you bring in so many great specialists to talk about it really quick. We only have one more minute, but the biggest group attacking you, how would you describe them? You put out a book like this, it seems it seems, innocuous enough. How to prevent autism. You should be allowed to write this book. But you came under attack. Who's attacking you?

To cure a disease that was not here a hundred years ago? It did not exist 100 years ago. Something is hurting our children. And yes, it is an injury. If we all end up being autistic that we will not procreate. There are so many problems. We will not be able to run this country. I'm all about acceptance. But how is it by stopping something or saying we can cure it? Do you become the bad guy? It's like, I always say, in Africa we knew that children were going blind because they had a vitamin A deficiency. And so the World Health Organization started putting vitamin A in salt and things that every poor kid uses just to get vitamin A to them. And it worked. We were able to curb some of the blindness. Does that mean we're anti blind people because we want to stop people from going blind? This neurodiversity argument is insane. Mark Blaxill has a brilliant book about how stupid this idea is that autism has always been here. Of course, we accept autistic children, as do you, your beautiful son.
