High above the circus of mainstream news media spin, death defying talk without a safety net. This is Highwire. Thank you for joining us. Good morning. Good afternoon. Wherever you are around the world, this is our second episode. We are up and running and having a really good time. I want to start off today with a crazy article that appeared on Facebook this week. It came from the Journal of Pediatrics. Now, for those of you who just joined the show for the first time and don't know who I am, I made a movie called VAXXED about vaccine safety and specifically about a cover up at the CDC. We have a whistleblower at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention named Dr. William Thompson has come forward and said that they're committing scientific fraud and covering up the dangers of vaccines. But anyway, that whole journey has taken me into a place I never expected. I was a medical journalist. So I'm into celebrating the best that medicine has to offer the best doctors, surgeons, cutting edge techniques.

I love science. That's what this is really about. But sometimes science appears to be purchased. It's bought, it's manipulated. Much like we found out about the tobacco industry when they were buying the science around tobacco and telling us it was safe. It now appears much of the same thing is taking place with vaccines. It's a hard reality. It's very difficult to wrap your head around. It's upsetting because I think not only have people been lied to, the doctors we trust have been lied to, and now they find themselves in a very difficult position. But today I want to talk a little bit about that, because it's how the medical establishment, the mainstream media, the AMA and the pediatric association, how they're framing this discussion, I think points to some of the alarm we should all have as citizens in the United States of America. And so this this came out on Facebook. This was a story that was published in the journal Pediatrics just last year. The title of it is "Unintended Consequences of Invoking the Natural in Breastfeeding Promotion." Now, I'm just going to read you a couple of the excerpts from here. You could certainly go to that journal and and look up this article and see all that it has to offer in its glory. But for me, this is totally insane. Listen to this. So it starts out with medical and "medical and public health organizations recommend that mothers exclusively breastfeed for at least six months."

"This recommendation is based on evidence of health benefits for mothers and babies, as well as developmental development, Developmental benefits for babies." Of course, that's what we all know. I think we knew, like during the times of the Dr. Spock book and things, there was this move away from breastfeeding. Everybody was putting their children on formula instead. And we had a real health issue around it. And so we've gotten back to recognizing that breastfeeding is actually important. Many studies show that even the contents and the vitamins and minerals and things that are delivered by breast milk cannot be found anywhere else in nature. And some studies show that that breast milk even changes depending on the child's need, if they're sick or they have other issues. So it's an incredible, brilliant, natural thing. For those of you that believe in divine design. God did a wonderful thing here in in creating breast milk that really makes our children healthier. But anyway, the the article goes on to say, "Promoting breastfeeding as natural may be ethically problematic." I want to read that again. "Promoting breastfeeding as natural may be ethically problematic. And even more troubling, it may bolster this belief that natural approaches are presumptively healthier. This may ultimately challenge public health's aims in other contexts, particularly childhood vaccination."

So obviously now we are watching this. This is an article saying that maybe we have to look at the fact that we are calling breastfeeding natural. Okay. It goes on "beneath the concerns of many Americans over vaccine safety, a specific and not necessarily illogical worldview is discernible. A rejection of the manufactured, the synthetic and the unnatural, and an embrace of the natural as a healthier and intrinsically better. Vaccines are often seen as unnatural, and boosting immunity naturally is viewed by some as the healthier and better approach." It goes on to say a little later, "this embrace of the natural over the unnatural appears in a variety of contemporary scientific and medical issues beyond vaccination, including rejection of genetically modified foods." Yeah. God forbid we have that. "A preference for organic over conventionally grown foods." People watch out for the organic. Stay away from it. The Pediatric Association thinks this is crazy talk "and rejection of assisted reproductive technologies, as well as concerns over environmental toxins and water fluoridation." Think about this. So are we saying that you're crazy to want to eat organic food, that, GMOs are the way to go and forget about the toxins in your water and air? We at the association, the pediatric association, the AMA, really stand behind polluting air and water and food and would rather you not involve yourself in thinking about it. For example, it goes on to say "the US Department of Health and Human Services, it's only natural breastfeeding promotion campaign is an explicit attempt to persuade women to breastfeed by framing breastfeeding as better than formula because it is natural."

"Furthermore, the American Academy of Pediatrics has referred to breast milk as the best and most natural food for infants." Okay. So at one point it looked like the pediatric association was getting this right. Now, are we going to see a sea change in how we deliver this? This article finishes up this way. "Whatever the ethics of appealing to the natural and breastfeeding promotion, it raises practical concerns. The natural option does not align consistently with public health goals." Really? Really the natural option does not go along with public health goals. Folks, this is where we have to start checking in with what then exactly is the goal of our health departments in this nation? Is it not to be natural, not to be healthy? Are we going to say that you should stop jogging? That's not the best way to lose weight. What you need to do is put yourself on drugs to lose weight because taking natural approaches like eating better or jogging in the morning could be detrimental to our overall health plan. I don't even, you can't make this stuff up. This isn't a conspiracy. I didn't write this. This is from the AAP.

This is outrageous. So, so I'll say it again. "The natural option does not align consistently with public health goals. If doing what is natural is best. In the case of breastfeeding, how can we expect mothers to ignore that powerful and deeply persuasive worldview when making choices about vaccination? If breastfeeding promotion frames the factory made option as risky or unhealthy, what should parents conclude when choosing between factory made vaccines and boosting immunity naturally." For those of you that really want to try and wrap your head around this, I say that if you stop your average person on the street and said, How do vaccines work? I think they describe it like this. They would say, well, there's this tiny little bit of a virus that's put in some inert substance like salt water, and it's injected into us. And because it's such a small amount, we we develop an immunity without actually getting the disease. For those of you that would have a more eloquent explanation, great. But I think that's where most of us that's what I thought. I think that's what most doctors honestly think is how vaccines work. But the truth is, is that is the definition of homeopathy. A tiny little amount of something that goes in our body and we develop an immunity towards it. Vaccines, actually, as they have pointed out, factory made vaccines do not just have the antigen or the virus in them and some salt water.

They have things like mercury, the second most deadly toxic substance on earth, aluminum, a known neurotoxin, formaldehyde. What was the last time you saw an article in the paper that some toy from China had formaldehyde on it, so we sent it back? Well, apparently we don't want it on our toys, but it's great to inject it right into your infant day. One old baby, two month old baby, four month old baby, six month old baby. Because we do it over and over and over again and incredibly toxic levels. And then forget about aborted fetal tissue. That's right. We're injecting the DNA of dead babies, aborted babies into our own babies. I've done some look into the research around this, and I think it's going to prove to be actually problematic when we think about GMO foods. What if we're all genetically modified because of our vaccine program? A lot of science is now showing that the way they use this foreign DNA that's coming not only from dead babies, but also other animals, we inject animal DNA into us with these vaccines because that's how we grow these viruses. It's all a part of the process of making a vaccine. Well, in our infinite wisdom, we chop the DNA up into a bunch of little pieces. This is what we thought because we didn't really have any science around it.

We'd never injected foreign DNA into a baby. So we thought, Well, I mean, theoretically it seems like it would be a lot safer to just chop these DNA strands into little pieces versus have these big DNA strands floating around in an environment where other DNA exists. Now, there's science showing that because we've chopped it into these little pieces, our own DNA strands are absorbing them into and genetically modifying our own DNA. I think there's more science coming on this very, very scary idea, though, that we would be absorbing some other person or some other animals DNA into our own. The science looking at this thinks that maybe it's causing this rise in childhood cancers among other things that have really increased since vaccines came along. But anyway, finishing out this article, "we should think twice before referencing the natural in breastfeeding promotion, even if it motivates women to breastfeed." That comes from the pediatric association to you. It came out last year in March, but some people on Facebook really uncovered it and brought it to certainly my attention among many others this week. So I guess what we've come to the conclusion then that breastfeeding is the gateway drug to natural health. You can't think of anything crazier than this.

So if you're one of these people out there that wants to eat organic food has a problem with genetically modified food doesn't want glyphosate, which has now been joined Prop 65 here in California. We're going to list it as a carcinogen, which hopefully they'll start labeling on food. But if you have problems with pesticides on your food, GMO food, maybe you're into chiropractic, or perhaps you like to go to Pilates class and God forbid you jog in the morning to lose weight versus take a drug. Apparently you have those thoughts because you must have been breastfed. And we must put an end to this insanity. Now that comes from the scientific body that we are told we are supposed to be listening to. Folks, it's time to start doing your own thinking. We cannot trust scientific bodies that clearly now are working for the pharmaceutical industry. They're funded by these industries. They're funded by Merck, by Sanofi, Aventis, Pfizer. They're funded by Monsanto, who is spraying our food with with deadly chemicals and telling us that we shouldn't eat organic food. All of this is the total corruption of the health bodies we were supposed to believe in. It's also the corruption of our government. As I've said before, the pharmaceutical industry is now the most powerful lobby in Washington. They're outspending oil and gas 2 to 1. Think about that. We grew up knowing that that the energy sector was one of the most powerful lobbies in Washington.

Now pharma is outspending them \$2 for every \$1 the energy sector spending. And I ask you, what do you think they're doing there? Do you think they're fighting for the safety of your children? Do you think they're fighting for our safety? Because I'm not into conspiracy theories. I'm into looking at the facts and the proof. I'm a journalist and what I see is them telling us exactly what they believe. When we saw the EpiPen get jacked up a couple of weeks ago, six times what it originally cost, the Congress called that company in to ask questions, saying, you know, we used to call this carpet bagging. You're taking advantage of a need. We now have a need that every classroom in America needs an EpiPen. Now it's a totally different discussion. Why we have that need. I think you can blame vaccines for part of that because we didn't need an EpiPen in my classroom when I was a kid. I can't remember a single school where I couldn't bring a peanut butter and jelly sandwich. But this is the new norm. This is our new health. And in this new world of health, we need EpiPens everywhere. So why the Congress asks the industry, Would you jack up the price of something that is obviously selling like hotcakes? You're making a ton of money off of it. And they say to our faces, because you make a mistake, we do not work for the patients or the citizens of this country or the world.

I have a great show today. I have an amazing guest I am really excited to bring in here. This is someone that, as I said, because I've been on this this tour all year discussing vaccine risk awareness, which is really what this is. They want to call everybody involved in this movement anti-vaxxer. It's not true. There's many of us that would just love to see a vaccine program that was perfectly safe and effective. But the truth is that kids will be murdered this year by the vaccine program. They will die. That's a fact. Other kids will have their brains swell. They'll have a neurological event, and they will never be the same again. Some of them will never, ever say, I love you, Mommy, ever again after visiting their pediatrician.

And yes, I think being natural is a part of how we're going to make the society healthier. The less and less natural we get, the more and more antibiotics we use, the more and more nature seems to find a way around it and put us in jeopardy. As many of you know, we think this may be the end of the antibiotic age because we've overused it. We're looking at similar problems with vaccines. But back to my guest. This is a powerful individual that has brought the truth of vaccine dangers to his community, the African-American community. I've been on tour and met with. Him several times. We're going to get into vaccines and we're also going to get into some of the controversy around the Nation of Islam. So, folks, I want to bring in Brother Tony Muhammad, who is the Western chapter leader of the Nation of Islam. Tony, thank you for joining me today.

Man, it's my honor, Del. Really it is. It's a it's an honor and a great privilege to be with another freedom fighter, standing with a man in yourself whom I've come to know over the years and know that a very, very sincere, a man who loves humanity, a man who wants to see all of our children safe. So thank you for this great opportunity to speak to you as well as your listening audience, because you know, the enemy of us all have divided us, have built walls between us, and a lot of people benefit off of having us at one another. And this is a beautiful time, you know, for those of us to come together, learn about the Nation of Islam for yourself. Don't go off of a soundbite on NBC, CBS, CNN. All of these particular medias are controlled by the very forces you and I have joined together to fight. And we are finding out we all have been duped.

That's right. Yeah. One of the things I think is really fascinating about this topic, you know, there's the African-American community has been used, throughout time in testing vaccines. With some black leader that he felt was fearless and unafraid because Bobby Kennedy and others, Michel Ford, had gone to other black leaders and none of them. Would even listen to what they had to say, let alone get involved to make sure that this issue was not revisiting us. So I get a call from Rizza Islam and he said, Hey, you're not going to believe this, but Bobby Kennedy would like to have a conversation with you. I'm like, you're like you're talking about, like, Camelot Kennedy Kennedys. He said, Yes. I said, Well, what does he want to talk to me about? We believe that Christ will return with God, not Muhammad. And we are to believe in the truth of any religion. See, all truth works together. It don't fight against each other. But there are some of us who take that truth and interpret it in a sinister way. Then that becomes what is damaging in America. Black people. Of course, you know, we wasn't we didn't come over here on a cruise ship. We came over here on a cruise ship. The worst treatment ever happened to any people in history, happened to wee black people in America. So we lost everything. Many of my ancestors were Muslims. You can get the movie Roots. Kunta Kinte was a muslim and the founding father said, Whatever you do, don't allow the black man to ever get back that religion because no Muslim will call another white man master. Only God can be master in your life. And so therefore, we were buried with the Bible. The Bible was used to make slaves out of us. There are scriptures in the Bible that the slave master used to carry out slavery, where they took and misinterpreted certain aspects of the Bible to verify their wickedness done in Jesus name. So therefore, we use biblical scriptures because our people don't know the Quran. So we speak the truths of the Bible as we know it, to impart it on our people, to get them to see better what has happened to us.

Brother, if I find some in Buddhism, if I see truth, I'm grabbing that. If I see some in Hinduism, I'm grabbing that. I've been among my Native Americans, brother. I've been in the inipi. I went in the sweat lodge. Oh my God, I see truth when you go in, Any and every Indian male have to know the suffering of a female. I see why I said, My God, I love truth. So we are lovers of truth and we will live on that truth and we will die on that truth. And we will fight for truth. Truth only. So that's what we have. And that's what's dangerous. When you got people in high places, Brother Del, that don't want to see you and I come together, they want you to look at me with suspicion. But this movement has caused us to come into contact with many Caucasian people who are quite surprised.

And I was raised to think the same thing that we're divided by, all our religious leaders in many ways tend to speak to the things we disagree on and and separate us out. And I was raised to think that that really is that Satan right there that's that's or whatever, you know that thing is that divides us because there's so much that religion does agree on. And why wouldn't we be looking at that? I think about like, just not to wax too biblical here, but the Tower of Babel, you know what I mean? God sends us out. All of a sudden we are speaking different languages, we're coming from different places, and we have to go back to our place and use our language to speak. And I remember once talking to a friend of mine who, you know, was really, really focused on on he was going to be a Christian minister and great good on on you. But he had a real issue with Buddhism and Islam and all of this. And I said, in my thinking, your God actually is the one true? God is not as strong as I see my God, because your God only speaks to Christians, which is only, this sliver of humanity, a large one.

But, whereas I think wouldn't God in the great infinite wisdom, speak to all different people in a way that they could hear it based on where they come from, what they're going through, Isn't it possible that God speaks through many different people? And yes, the message gets convoluted, by the messengers all the time. But I have a hard time believing that, like one of my issues has always been one of my big questions is, when when people say, you have to take Christ as your savior in order to be, find a place in heaven, my question is always, So you're telling me that if there's some person down in a tribe in South Africa or South America, or anywhere that never was introduced to Jesus, even as an idea. But all they did was get up every morning and treat everybody with love and respect, treated them as they wanted to be treated themselves, went out of their way to be helpful, one out of their way to be caring and loving and protect everyone around them. They live an entire life like that, but because they didn't know the name of Jesus. They're not going to heaven. I have a problem with with that delineation.

I just think that we just like vaccines or any other discussion. We've been pigeonholed into bumper sticker ideas of what life is. When you really need to read the Bible yourself, you need to you need to take in the words of Jesus yourself, not just have some minister you visit once a week that tells you what parts of it they want to tell you. Our job is to take in the words ourselves just like the same thing in the medical community. Don't just take your doctor's word for it. You need to ask for the insert wrapped around the vaccine itself and read it yourself.

We had Tamir Rice, a 12 year old boy in a park playing with a toy gun. Police officers pull up on him and in less than five seconds, murder this boy. He's 12 years old. Mike Brown, they tried to make him guilty.

Mike Brown, they said he stole some. Now they're telling us he didn't steal it. He paid for it. But yet he's dead. That's all day, every day in the black community. And then you have the forensic specialists. They lie to protect the police officer. You have judges who lie to protect the police officers. And so what Minister Farrakhan is doing, he was warning white America and he was warning America in general, just like your founding fathers, when they was put in the 13 colonies by the British, they kept warning the British. Taxation without proper representation is tyranny. You all are mistreating us in these colonies. Stop it. We're about to explode. We're about to blow up. The king wouldn't listen. And so a group of white militias formed dressed up like Native Americans to hide their identity, went to the Boston Harbor, threw tea over, burned it, rioted to get the king's attention. He still didn't listen Del. So 70 white militias start killing the British soldiers. That's when the king paid attention.

Nearly a million babies killed. Who's going to hit those mothers grievously when they say, hey, you didn't find no weapon, Who's going to pay for this? And you drive that people crazy. Out of that came ISIS. And it seems like people, no matter who they are when you're mistreating another group, seem like we can't get your attention until you start feeling what we're feeling.

He read what you said who go outside of that law. That's all he said. And we should hunt that person down.

How do you think that you know more than everybody else, you know, And are you talking about, you know, talk to the pastors.
