Just want to let you know we're experiencing some technical difficulties today, so we're only streaming right now at Thehighwire.com. So on our platform are streaming to all of the other places, X accounts and things like that. Roku will have to happen at a later date, but if you know people that watch right now and maybe they don't use the website, go ahead and text your friends and let them know we're live on the Highwire. We're going to figure out what's going on later, but we want to get this show rolling because it's a very, very important show. There's a lot happening right now in the world of vaccinations, especially this week. I think one of the most devastating blows that has ever been delivered to pediatricians has happened this week. So a warning to all pediatricians, to all people out there. I think your days may be numbered if we don't do something about it. The bill creates a new process for short term guardianships in probate court. Now, this allows parents to designate someone to care for their children temporarily while maintaining their parental rights.

They will be authorized to enroll children in school and consent to their medical care with an affidavit in the event of a parent's parents detention or deportation.

Thousands of opponents of the bill rallied outside the Capitol on Tuesday. Many citing concerns about potential misuse of the affidavit. Concerns about child safety. Should the bill pass and the language included in the bill?

There are no safeguards in that affidavit. There is no signature. There is no parent permission required on the permission slip. This is a child traffickers dream.

Well, there's a march on the Capitol in California against AB 495 just a couple of days ago. I'm joined by one of the mothers and warriors that was at that, of course. I mean, am I not understand any Yahoo can show up with like, an affidavit they've written out themselves? There's no need for parent signatures saying I'm picking up the child today. Is that what we're talking about?

It can be any adult can come into a school. They have an affidavit form that they fill out. They check a box that says they can't get ahold of the parent. They can become the guardian of that child, remove the child from school, the this person that becomes the guardian and caregiver. Yeah. Yes.

"I am unable to contact the parents or other persons having legal custody of the minor at this time". This is in the bill "to notify them of my intended authorization." And this is okay. This is okay. All of the years, I mean, when we grew up, our parents would say to us, nobody picks you up but me. I don't even care if it's your uncle or a best friend of mine. Unless I have told you. Unless this is clear. And now California thinks you need a law saying anybody can just sign their name, bring an affidavit saying couldn't get all the parents. Give me that child now.

And guess what this does. If a person comes in and says they're now the caregiver bringing this affidavit form, first of all, they don't have to have a background check. There's no check of the home. There's no ID required to be checked or verified, both when they fill out the form and when they go to a school. Schools are released from any kind of liability to check ID or any kind of verification. The only thing the bill says is that a person can give their Social Security number or the Medicare Medi-Cal card, and that's sufficient. So there's no parent signature required. There is nothing to confirm that this person is a legitimate caregiver authorized by the parent. And not only can they pick up the child from school, but they then can become the person who authorizes medical care, dental care, everything and anything that would be within a parent. Of course, a guardians jurisdiction to take care of your child, so it is probably Del. I think one of the worst bills that we've seen in California yet. And the problem is that the legal loopholes that this creates, anyone can come and pick up a child anyway. And it's not just public schools, it's private schools. It's home school. Just imagine

Who authorized this bill. I mean, I want to know who these people are. Are they? Or do I share DNA with these people. Why do you think we have helicopter parents? You're arrested if you let your child walk, down the street to go to a park down the road. But anybody can pick up your child now, I think we've got a few more lines from this bill we could take a look at. Here we go. "A caregivers authorization affidavit that meets the requirements of this part. Authorizes a caregiver 18 years of age or older who completes items 1 to 4, inclusive of the affidavit provided in section 6552, and signs the affidavit to enroll a minor in school and consent to school related medical care on behalf of the minor" goes on. "School related medical care means medical care, including immunizations, physical examinations, and medical examinations conducted in schools for pupils that is required by state or local governmental authority as a condition for school enrollment or participation. Local education agency related extracurricular activities." I mean, can you imagine you're not vaccinating your kid or they find out or whatever the case, they just, find a relative, find anybody that will take your kid.

I got an affidavit. I am the parent for the day. I'm going to catch them up on everything. I mean, this is just one more step in this incredible slippery slope that California's been in ever since SB 277. But Amy, speaking of oh, here's the sponsors, I want to I just want to remember these people forever. I guess the main sponsor is Celeste Rodriguez. This is a terrible idea, Celeste. I don't know what planet you're living on. Damian Connolly, John Harabedian, Ash Kalba, Alex Lee, Catherine Stefani, Rick Zbur hey, if you live in California, I think you got to think about, what you're doing there. Is this leadership? Is this the type of thing you voted for? Unbelievable. But speaking of SB 277, where all of this starts, I know we're fighting lawsuits like crazy. Of course. And the amazing thing about this, too, is we're asking President Trump not to impede on state rights, because you can't do that. But what we're asking him to do is to draft and sign an executive order that will restore store religious liberty by defunding any educational institution or state that is violating the First Amendment.

Like, of course, why don't you come and see a taping? You get to see it, sit in the control room and watch how this show is all put together. Visit the brick, have breakfast with us. So, uh, I hope you'll take this opportunity to be a part of all the great work that we're doing. And sort of stake your claim that you were here, present and accounted for. You made a difference at the time where it was most important for the future of humanity, our species, and certainly the United States of America.

Absolutely goes into effect in 2027, 2028 school year. There's so little leeway there and they're working out details of it. First state to do this requires at least one annual mental health checkup. And what they're doing is the states are partnering with psychiatric hospitals and schools to have like a centralized resource for for helping these kids out. But as you heard in that clip there, you know, again, we're medical izing normal human emotions that children's children have sadness, fear, worry. And you're putting it into a system that a psychiatric system with a limited toolbox, that has really been a pretty big failure. If you look at just the numbers of kids with mental health, this is a disorder that's been going up for quite some time now. And I want to I want to put the the irony of this is you have schools, the schools get this power. The schools are the same people that supercharge the mental health disorders during Covid. They were the ones here, the teachers unions that were blocking schools from reopening during Covid, even though the science showed that they could. And we know from the Great Barrington Declaration that closing schools created a mental health crisis that surged a mental health crisis. And this isn't the first time we've seen the state or schools try to come between children and their parents, using mental health as a guise. And this is something in 2014, as Scotland, they tried this. They called it the name person scheme. And what happened was basically they would sign a health agent for every preschool child.

Everyone would have a government agent to deal with their health and their wellbeing, and that would follow them throughout school. You can imagine what could go wrong there. Well, that was challenged in court in 2016. They said it violated the human rights. It violated family life under the European Convention on Human Rights, violated privacy 2019. They scrapped it. The Scottish Government just scrapped it because it was a complete failure. There was so much pushback on this, but let's let's look at what this actually would mean. So your child is in school. The parent is not there and it go to a mental health screening. Well, what kind of questions did they ask? Would they ask? You know, they're going to ask science based questions. Would they ask? Are your parents vaccine hesitant? Have you had all your vaccines? Do you think they wouldn't ask that? Why would they ask that? Well, that is what the science is saying. If you don't believe me, here's some of just a little section of the science. "Why are anti-vaxxers willing to harm themselves and others? Psychology today." Here's another one. "Vaccine hesitancy is associated with negative psychiatric outcomes." That was during the pandemic. And you just showed a study that showed 60% of pregnant women parents will not be following the CDC's vaccine schedule. So are we to believe that those 60% of kids in the US, because of their parents, aren't giving them the shots, are going to have negative psychiatric problems? Well, that's what the science says. Attorney General Andrew Bailey filed suit against Blackrock, also State Street and Vanguard for illegally manipulating the energy markets. And he said this is a press release "over several years. The three asset managers acquired substantial stock holdings in every significant publicly held coal producer in the United States, thereby gaining the power to control the policies of the coal companies using their combined influence over the coal market."

We and people watching this may have what we've been watching for however long you've been watching the Highwire, you know that the vaccine conversation, we've been told that settled science for a long time. We've shown it wasn't. Our our ICAN lawyers have shown that it wasn't as well from FOIA documents or depositions. And so the climate conversation is the same thing. And here's a study, a new study that just came out literally called "Unsettling the Science" talking about the complex climatic system. And it says here, "the research presented here challenges the ideas that we live in a greenhouse, and that science can be settled and revisits the most fundamental topics related to climate." These researchers basically are suggesting they replace this word greenhouse gas with atmospheric radiative effect, because the idea of a greenhouse is not really how Earth works. And that is actually something that came about in the late 50s, early 60s, when this Club of Rome push happened, you had this buzzword greenhouse greenhouse effect. So they're saying, let's go take away these buzzwords and let's get back to actual scientific terms when we're talking about this. So they conclude this. There is "there's an empirically verified atmospheric radiative effect in the atmosphere, not only on Earth, but also on other planets on Earth. Air is dominated by water vapor and clouds, with CO2 playing a very minor role, let alone human added CO2, which represents only 4% of total emissions to the atmosphere."

So they go on to say, "focusing on one of the factors affecting the climatic system, namely the anthropogenic CO2 emissions, and basing on models that emphasize that this factor may distort our perception of the big picture and can be detrimental to science, whose objective is to pursue the truth." And that's all we want. Here is the truth. We want actual science. And while we're continuing to wait for actual science, although there's a legion of scientists doing this, they've just been pushed out of the mainstream conversation until now. We're having, again this rapid societal push with ridiculous, ridiculous suggestions at this point that are moving into policy on how to fight climate change. Here's one from Associated Press. "People often miscalculate climate choices. A study says one surprise is owning a dog." So I had to backtrack this to the actual study because I'm thinking, what's going on here? You go to this study and they're looking at climate action literacy interventions. So they're looking at what people think they're doing to fight climate change. And what are they actually doing. So they said this. They they propose this question. "Do people perceive the effectiveness of their climate behaviors? They say we found that participants significantly underestimated the mitigation potential of behaviors, like not adopting a dog or taking one fewer long haul flights, while greatly overestimating the potential of behaviors like using efficient appliances or recycling comprehensively." So again, they're basically saying

So I mean, I don't think they're going to be able to get people to not have dogs anymore, to stop loving dogs or adopting dogs. But I don't know. I really don't understand that whole aspect of this, but good luck. But they're also saying long haul flights. There has been a big push when you're seeing this now. There's been a push to keep people locally. You shouldn't be traveling anymore because it's bad for the climate taking flights. That's why they're seeing these 15 minute cities pop up. That's why you're seeing people talking about ride sharing. You're even getting automatically driving cars that that could be backfired pretty quick. But you got to ask the question, how do you inspire people to travel less? You don't want people to visit places, right? Well, it's not just going to magically say you can't travel anymore.

This is absolute zero and this was the UK fires document, and we know that this is on the agenda in 2029 by 2029. You can see here on this chart they want all airports except Heathrow, Glasgow and Belfast close by 2030 to 2049. All remaining airports closed so the airport industry reaches net zero by stop stopping to fly. The airport industry is gone. There's no more airports, but when it comes to tourism right now, since we still can fly, the tourist spots are trying to make it a little more uncomfortable. Here's Greece, for example. Greece is shutting down beaches. It declares 198 beaches is fully protected. This is because of the climate. And so they're taking out the umbrellas, and the sunbeds are just making it a little more uncomfortable for you to be there. But when that doesn't work and when taxing doesn't work, then the protests happen and it looks like this.

And you hit on a great point because there's a difference. There used to be a difference between environmentalism and conservation. Conservation. And there's a big difference now because one is an agenda driven thing. Conserving natural resources is a good thing. Cleaning up rivers, cleaning up pollution that goes after these big polluters. And that is something that environmentalism used to be before this agenda came in, and kind of sidetrack this and actually took a lot of the funding away from it. But we're seeing the tentacles spread out everywhere. You see it in science, you see it literally in the grassroots. And it's not grassroots, as you pointed out, but on the streets with protests. They're very, very kind of like Black Lives Matter, very similar to that. You see the slogans, everyone's got a slogan. They they're harassing people, but you see it illegally as well. So there's a lawsuit now, the first of its kind is the Associated Press. And wrongful death lawsuit says "Big Oil contributed to Heat wave and woman's death." This is a complaint filed in Washington state court accusing seven oil companies of being responsible for a 2021 heat wave that killed a woman. So, I mean, this is trying to connect those two ends. I guess they're going to try to do that in this lawsuit, but this will set a massive precedent if this happens, and a lot of these large companies would be on the hook for, I don't know, when it rains a little too much or when an extra hurricane comes rushing through. I guess we can blame the companies for that, because global warming, it's hard to see the logic here, but this is what's going on in the. This is the United States to remind you, this isn't something we're seeing over in Europe, but this is right here in Washington state.

We've been three years at this fight in West Virginia. But one of the longest fights ever. In fact, the second lawsuit we ever filed was to reinstate the vaccine. Like, why is the vaccine task force? We started with a FOIA request. The vaccine task force that was supposed to make vaccines safer. It was written to the 1986 Vaccine Injury Compensation Act, that terrible law. But in it, they did have some provisions to make vaccines safer. But instead, as we proved through our lawsuits, they disbanded that vaccine. You know, safety group, task force. And so now Robert Kennedy Jr has just reinstated a vaccine safety task force. This is huge news. One of the big developments, he's really been putting his pedal to the metal these last two weeks. "Hhs finally restores task force on safer childhood vaccines on the back of removing the childhood Covid vaccine," which we've talked about earlier, and pulling funding for, I think, \$500 million worth of investment into looking at, you know, new mRNA technologies. So great stuff happening there. But this one, this is a big one for us. This was one of our early fights. And I want to talk to our attorney, Aaron Siri, who is at the forefront of that initial fight right now. Aaron, this is a huge development. Talk about a long time coming. We're talking about 2017. We were involved in in this lawsuit against the government.

Sure. Well, when you look around everybody who's watching the show. Look around your room. Look at every consumer product around you, okay. Whether it's the computer you're looking at right now or the TV, whether it's the car in your driveway, whether it's every material in the walls of your house, literally every consumer product around you. If the people, the company that make those products design it in a defective way, they could have made it safer. They could have done it with ingredients that weren't going to be as harmful. You can sue them for doing that to make it a better product. It's called a design defect claim. It's the primary way you hold product manufacturers accountable. But leading up to 1986, when there were only three routines of vaccines in America. That's it. Right. A child by the age of one back then got three injections according to CDC schedule. Today we're at 29. Anyways, those three vaccines were causing so much harm. And the manufacturers were all going out of business. You know, it's reported that there were six manufacturers of measles vaccine down to one. There were, I think six around for pertussis, down to one, three for the oral polio down to one. So there's one left for each. Now, when companies face that crossroads, what do you normally do? Your car is blowing up. What do you do? Your plane's falling out of the sky.

Your building materials are causing all kinds of harm to people causing cancer. You make a better, safer product. That is what happens. The self-interest that companies have in making money, right? The economic self-interest drives them to make a safer product. Nobody needs to push them. No agency needs to force them. They automatically want to do it cause they don't want to lose money. And if they're really resistant, then they get a lawsuit and then they do it fine. Congress, however, in its wisdom, decided, hey, you know what? Instead of making you bank a better, safer vaccine product, we're just going to do something unprecedented. We're going to give you immunity. We're going to make it so that every child that you hurt, child that you kill with your product. Don't worry, they can't sue you for it. We're going to let you continue to sell your harmful product into the marketplace, and we'll just make it so the people who are harmed, they can't see you. That is what the 1986 act did. And it didn't just do it for those three vaccines back then. It did it for any other vaccine that was created thereafter, and hence the explosion of what we see now when Congress did that. Okay. And I'm not giving credit a lot of credit to Congress. Okay. No slight on any particular member of Congress.

But in its collective wisdom, it decided that, well, you know, we've kind of mucked up the works here. The companies, they don't care about safety anymore. In fact, they have the opposite incentive. Right. Their incentive financially is to do as little safety before licensure as we know from clinical trials and afterwards. So we're going to transfer all those safety responsibilities to To the federal government, to the federal health authorities, the Department of Health and Human Services. And how did they do that? How did they transfer those responsibilities? They did it in a provision of law for the lawyers out there. 42 U.S.C. 380 Dash 27, okay, called the mandate for safer childhood vaccines. It's three simple parts to it. Okay. And, you know, when Congress passes laws like that, a lot of times they'll put in, let's say, one page. So sometimes they'll put in a page and they'll say, okay, do this. And then they'll be like a thousand pages of regulations implementing it and hundreds of thousands of pages of reports and so forth going forth. You know, like when the when the government said make when there's a law that says to make drugs, you know, pure and safe, you know, there's a billion regulations about that. When it came to vaccines and the mandate for safer childhood vaccines. Right. Um, and you look at that, there's actually pretty much no regulations separately, Most importantly, it's got three little parts.

Part one it's saying make the vaccines as safe as possible. Government. Okay. Because we screwed this whole system up. Companies aren't going to do it. So we're going to ask you, Secretary, make it as safe in every possible way when you read it. It's literally every possible, uh, you know, it's in the distribution, it's in the manufacturer, it's in the, uh, you name it, it's every single aspect of it. Part two is something called a task force. It creates a task force for safer childhood vaccines, which is comprised of the head of NIH, CDC, and FDA. And the role of this task force is to make recommendations to the Secretary of HHS on how to make the vaccine safer in every possible way. And then section three of the mandate for safer child vaccines is that there's supposed to be a report submitted to Congress by the Secretary to HHS every two years detailing how have vaccines been made safer in the prior two years. And so when we were at the very beginning, you know, I remember, you know, we sat down, pulled up this provision and said, look, a place to start. Vaccine safety is what are they done? Let's look at the biannual reports to begin with. Let's see. Let's read them.

Still today they still haven't done it because we did a follow up FOIA request few years later. And they had to admit again, we've still never done they, there, at this point, openly and blatantly not following this law. Now, separately, we also had to end up suing them on on for the recommendations of task force. Maybe if we said fine, maybe they just never submitted the report to Congress. But what were the recommendations on how to make vaccines safer? Because these are the two easy.

Did all of the benefits the companies got and did the lack of market protections? And no, the task force was supposed to continue to do this, but it didn't. And so they had to make that embarrassing capitulation. And I'll end my long monologue by saying that it's okay. When you look at the mandate for safer childhood vaccines, submitting biannual reports that Congress every two years putting a report together that's easy, making recommendations, just write and stuff out. Easy to. And if they're not doing the easy parts of the mandate for safer child vaccines, do you really think that they were doing the hard part of the mandate? Section one, which is actually doing the real hard work to make the vaccines, make sure they're only safe vaccines come out and that they're as safe as possible, and they continue to be safe afterwards. I think the I think the question answers itself.
