Action. Good morning, good afternoon, good evening. Wherever you are out there in the world. I'm in Sardinia, Italy. Hello everybody. I am here in Utopia. Almost. It's called Sardinia. I'm surrounded by olive trees, wine vineyards, orchards with peaches and pears. And we've been eating some of the most amazing, clean, beautiful food you could ever imagine, and also drinking some of the local wines. But not today, not for the show. We're completely sober and ready to have a great time to share with you what it's been like to travel Italy, to be screening our film An Inconvenient Study to a Brand New audience. And then I've also had the opportunity to sit down with doctors, scientists, and media experts that were here in the epicenter of Covid. Remember when it was all a panic and everyone freaked out and it looked like everyone was dying in Italy? Well, they were in the middle of it. And I'm going to share with you what I've learned through this incredible investigation we've been on here in Italy. But first for a feeling of what this amazing trip has been like. Well, it's just been an absolutely spectacular trip. The reception to An Inconvenient Study has been really amazing, and we're going to get to some of the most powerful interviews I think I've done, uh, throughout the experience of Highwire. And I'm going to show you where a couple of things have actually changed my perspective of what happened during Covid. But first, I want to talk about something that happened while I was **here. There was a post that Robert Kennedy Jr put out that, um, I took a little issue with, and every** once in a while I feel like I have to speak my truth and that's what I did. This was his post. "Today, I signed a targeted Prep Act declaration to support the development and deployment of medical countermeasures related to any virus or virus, which can cause the deadly respiratory illness, hantavirus pulmonary syndrome. This action helps remove barriers to research and response efforts while we continue monitoring the recent outbreak linked to the South Atlantic cruise ship. Hhs is taking the situation seriously and will continue working to protect public health and support the safe development of potential treatments and countermeasures." You know, I have to be honest, I don't like the Prep act. Robert Kennedy Jr. I didn't think like the Prep act either, which is why I was so surprised he would sort of celebrate using the Prep Act to do anything whatsoever.

I remember so many inspiring strategy discussions during your campaign, providing liability protection to corporate interests for a virus that killed three people out of 7 billion was not one of them." Um, you know, I thought about what I was saying there, and honestly, the truth is, you know, I want to have some sense of humor about this. Uh, we did have so many inspired thoughts, strategies on what Robert Kennedy Jr could do if he ever found himself in a place of power. Of course, we were thinking president most of the way, but he ended up being HHS secretary. Our entire reason for running for president was, you know, maybe he'd be able to put someone great in as the HHS secretary instead when he got that position. I've said so many times It was truly a miracle. I think even better, at least from my perspective, than him being president of the United States. But, you know, there's a lot of people that said they agreed. They were frustrated that he was using the Prep Act. But I did get braced by a few of our followers.

And, you know, someone I trusted a lot in doctor, um, Robert Malone, this is what he had to say about my post on X. "If you actually read the new declaration, what Kennedy issued is remarkably narrow. It is specifically tied to the Andes virus outbreak associated with the MV Hondius incident and close contacts linked to the chain of transmission. The declaration does not authorize lockdowns. It does not authorize mask mandates. It does not suspend civil liberties. It does not create a vaccine mandate. It does not authorize the development of a vaccine. It does not declare a national public health emergency. There are no FEMA camps hiding behind the shrubbery waiting to abduct your Labrador retriever." Uh, thank you, Doctor Robert Malone. First I want to say, uh, I love it that he. We all are here to keep each other honest. The truth is, is, you know, when I think about this post, first of all, you have to remember, um, I still see myself in many ways as Robert Kennedy Jr. S director of communication. I guess I'll never, uh, graduate from that feeling. But to say the words prep act is just a media disaster. I would either have said to him, don't use those words or for you do you better post exactly how you're using this? He didn't do that. There was no link, uh, to what the actual language was.

And I was in Italy. Sure, I didn't take the time to read it. I'm glad Robert Malone made it clear that it was very specific. But let me be clear, it is very specific. We have some of the excerpts from it here. So here are some of the specifics that Robert Malone is pointing out. "I recommend, under the conditions stated in this declaration, the manufacturer testing, development, distribution and voluntary Administration. Use of the covered countermeasures in individuals possibly exposed to Andes virus on the MV Hondius, and in individuals who have had close contact with individuals possibly exposed to Andes virus on the MV Hondius." It goes on to say "covered countermeasures are favipiravir," which is just one drug. And this is what Robert Malone's pointing out it isn't a bunch of vaccines or any drug you can imagine. It's for one specific drug. And he says, "I have determined that liability protections are afforded to covered persons only for recommended activities involving covered countermeasures that are obtained for voluntary administration to individuals in accordance with an approved I'd application." So there you have it. For anyone that saw that post, maybe you were upset like I was. Maybe you're still upset. Or, you know, perhaps you think that the Prep act is a bad idea. It is very narrow. Let's be clear about that. I will say that I don't like liability protection period.

I don't know why we ever have to have it. We've been having off label uses of drugs or drugs that need to come in for emergencies, like since the dawn of man, practically. We didn't need liability protection then. I don't know why we need it now. I think using the Prep act was just putting this thing in a bad light. It was great to see that he's responding. But also, I feel like what I was trying to say is, okay, you're dealing with hantavirus, but where's autism? You know, a hunter virus is affecting about three people so far out of 7 billion. Meanwhile, we have an issue affecting 1 in 30, uh, of boys and girls, or 1 in 12 point five boys in California, which we've discussed. I think a lot of us want to see some attention there. But all of that said, I want to be clear, even when I am maybe ribbing Robert Kennedy Jr a little bit, I still stand by what I've always said about him. I know the man. I know his intentions. I know he hasn't changed. I know he hasn't turned on us. I'm not worried that he isn't doing everything that he can inside of one of the most corrupt political systems that exist in the world. I wouldn't want that job. I'm really happy that he has that job. But I also believe that Donald Trump is making assumptions, and the administration around Donald Trump think that maybe Maha doesn't care or it doesn't matter.

I also am very concerned about the slippery slope we always see in situations like this. It starts out with one drug they crack, they crack the door open, but then pharma goes in is better than anything in the world at kicking it wide open and then robbing us of all of our rights. So I don't feel good about it. I still don't feel good about it. I understand that it was narrow, and I'm glad Bobby is obviously gone out of his way to make it as narrow as absolutely possible. But I want you to know I'm still going to state my truth. And if you feel I need an apology to apologize for what I said, I'd love to hear it right now. Actually, in your comments, do you think I overstated it? Did I understate it or did I get it just right? I'd love to hear what you have to say, but just know I'm always going to say what I think and what I feel, and that's what I hope you trust in me in the Highwire.

But I'm glad we have dialed in on what exactly these countermeasures are all about. Alright, we've got a huge show coming up. I'm going to go through some amazing interviews that really were mind changing for me. Alright, Jefferey, we will see if this works. We are trying to pull off a technological miracle because obviously I'm not in the, uh, the highest Wi-Fi area in the world. Maha is currently couched under the Trump administration. There's pros and cons to that. So goes politics. This is the game that we we all play as Americans. But the the spirit of Maha cuts through generations. Its history goes back decades. And when we see the media attacking this this spirit with flimsy headlines, we're gonna we're gonna we're gonna pick them apart. That's what we're going to do right here. So remember just about a month ago, a Boston judge or a Massachusetts judge halted Acip, halted everything Acip has done with its reconstituted members. Kennedy fired all 17 members, reconstituted with a wider swath of experts to really get to the heart of some of the big issues affecting the vaccine policy. Well, here's the headline from Reuters. This is an exclusive. They're calling it "U.S. Health Secretary Kennedy backs away from some recent changes to CDC panel." Oh my gosh. Well, if you're just reading headlines, you're thinking, there goes Maha. Well, you go into this article and it says this, "a replacement charter signed by Kennedy on May 14th and reviewed by Reuters, no longer contains the requirement for toxicologists, data scientists and other specific area knowledge. Rather, it says, members shall represent, quote, a balanced range of scientific, clinical and public health expertise." So really quick. Remember, he he had some time. Kennedy can reconstitute that charter. He can write it any way he wants.

By the way, Jefferey, you know, let's point out that it was ICAN that advised him to revise that charter. We sent a letter saying to Robert Kennedy Jr, why don't we turn lemons into lemonade? And since they've, you know, sort of broken apart ACIP with an activist judge, why don't you go ahead and broaden ACIP and bring in scientists that are working and doctors that are working with vaccine injury and autism can talk about the toxic effects of vaccines. So they have a broader coalition. When, you know, ACip has to approve things in the future. So I just want to point out that change in the charter was I you know, I think it was inspired because we actually sent a formal letter on behalf of ICAN stating all those issues.

And we reported that. And that was a success. And so Reuters is saying that's been withdrawn. Um, and apparently, according to Reuters, something new is going to be put out and it's going to have this language. Well, this to me shows that Kennedy is listening to his legal counsel because that is appeal. The Trump administration appealed the Massachusetts judge cancellation of basically of ACIP. So there's going to be an appeal. A judge will rule on this. So this language change is smart, it's effective. It's going to be a higher percentage that a judge will look at this and say, okay, that seems balanced. So Reuters headline should have said something like Kennedy strengthens the future court case to allow ACIP to continue its its revolutionary changes of the vaccine schedule to to, to catch up to recent science. But he didn't do that. Now let's go on to NBC news. Here's another one. We're just going to go right through these. Here's the headline "no child Deaths definitively Linked to Covid Shots. Fda says." Well, first of all, I want to bring people's attention to the fact that starting in late April to mid May, just about two weeks, the entire top echelon of the FDA has been reshuffled. You have Prasad stepping down. Marty Makary, the FDA director out, Tracy Beth Hoeg fired walked out. And that headline. Now, interestingly, the FDA suddenly is having this strong statement with no one to really push back on it. And you go into this, you go into this NBC news article, it says "the FDA's analysis surfaced in a letter Senator Ron Johnson sent this month to Health and Human Services Secretary Robert F Kennedy Jr regarding transparency around Covid vaccine safety."

"In the analysis dated December 5th, the FDA reviewed 96 reports of child deaths submitted to the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System through August 14th, 2025." Well, let's not let's not just trust NBC news. Let's go to Senator Ron Johnson's actual letter he sent to Kennedy. Here it is. This is the he's the chairman. This is the Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations. And he says this if you go down to that date, that's December 5th. He says "on May 4th, 2026, HHS provided the subcommittee a December 5th, 2025 memorandum detailing 96 pediatric deaths following Covid 19 vaccination, some of which were labeled as possibly or probably related to the vaccine." Johnson goes on to say this "NBC news completely left this out. The analysis described in this memorandum and conducted under your leadership," that's Kennedy, "provides even more evidence of the Biden administration's cover up of the safety risks associated with Covid 19 injections. I suspect there are many more additional records that are responsive to my December 15th, 2025 request." So they're still holding back records there. This is a major issue. Nbc news is reporting on this, this minor thing, and taking kind of a leap of faith in what what this actual letter is saying. And if they actually sat down, which they didn't with Senator Ron Johnson, they may have they may have gotten an interview like this. Take a listen.

Jackie. This is the the the most egregious government scandal in my lifetime. On March 1st, Peter Marks, the head of the division within FDA that approves vaccines and then surveils the safety was briefed that the algorithm they're using to analyze VAERS was going to completely mask and hide safety signals. 26 days later, he was shown 25 adverse events where there were safety signals, including sudden cardiac death, pulmonary infarction, Bell's palsy, different types of strokes. And he hid it. They are lying about it to this day. They continue to use the old algorithm that they knew would hide it. And then they went and lied to the American public. So again, the tens, hundreds of thousands of people that experienced adverse events, the tens of thousands that died on VAERS, reported on VAERS associated with that vaccine. These people ought to have a cause of action against those government officials that hid what the American people had a right to know. But they lied, bald faced, to to the American public. And unfortunately, I appreciate Fox covering this. Not one major network has picked up the story. This has been three weeks now. Like I said, the biggest scandal in my lifetime and mum's the word because everybody was complicit in it.

That's a headline. And maybe NBC news had the B team that day right in the article. But that that's the headline right there. The biggest scandal of his lifetime, which is no small potatoes in the times we're living in. So I want to go through one more conversation here of really hot topics. One of them is water fluoridation, reported in 2024 that a judge, San Francisco judge ruled on that it was a landmark ruling. Well, a ninth circuit has just overturned that ruling. "Ninth circuit revokes commandeering judge's fluoride ruling." Well, again, I'm going to have to correct that headline. So what they basically said it was a basically about a 6 to 8 page decision. And they were arguing on the standing of the ruling, not the merits. The court case went on for four years. It started in the summer of 2020 and a massive amount of evidence was produced. This ninth circuit basically said that because it started in the summer of 2020, it should have been ruled that the case should have been ruled on the evidence of all of the data up to 2020. Well, that's a problem because during that four years of this court case, major things happened. And the Ninth Circuit is asking is saying this judge, Judge Chen, should eliminate everything he learned, everything the public learned after 2020 to make health decisions for the entire American population. Well, what what's ignored? Well, this the National Toxicology Program did the largest review of the data ever on fluoride, which was put in this case, which both sides, by the way, said were highly relevant during this court case.

And it says this this is August 2024 "the state of the science concerning fluoride exposure." Kind of a big deal if you're litigating fluoride exposure. And it says this "18 of the 19 low risk of bias studies." So those are great studies "reported inverse associations between estimated fluoride exposure and IQ scores in children. 17 of these were statistically significant inverse associations." So here we go. Um and then Jama we have the Journal of American Medical Association kind of another big journal. "Fluoride exposure in children's IQ scores a systematic review and meta analysis." Again they looked at all the data separately from the national government's research. It says "this systematic review and meta analysis found" again here we go. "Inverse associations and a dose response association between fluoride measurements in urine and drinking water and children's IQ across large multicountry epidemiological literature." So again, the more fluoride, the lower children's IQ. That's what the court found. That's what the science finds. The ninth Circuit says, hey, don't worry about all that. We don't we don't care about all that because that came in after 2020. In a way, this is kind of like what Bayer and other foreign chemical companies are trying to do with the pesticide conversation. They're trying to say no new information should be allowed to be brought into courts. Actually, the label says it's safe and the EPA can review it maybe in about ten years. But until then, we go with the EPA says no new science is allowed. This is what the courts are doing. So you can see.

Well, what I want to say is, you know, this is a technicality. And to imagine this is not someone on trial for murder where they should just be given, you know, every benefit of doubt that's available to them. This is an industry that, as we know, is poisoning children. And so for these justices to say, essentially, we're going to rule, we're going to set back a development that has taken years and years in court on a technicality where it is clear the science is showing the IQ is dropping in our babies, but we don't care about that. We want to make sure that the industry gets to keep poisoning these children until you can mount another case that will get delayed for 5 to 10 more years. I mean, I, you know, I'm not a lawyer. I don't really get, you know, exactly the nuance of how courts work, but this just seems so egregious. You know what it really reminds me of? It reminds me of Andy Wakefield. And it's something that I've said for years. People say he's a fraud. You know, he committed fraud. Never, ever was it proved that Andy Wakefield committed fraud. The only thing they said was they got him on a technicality. He didn't get the proper ethical approval from his hospital to do the studies that were being done. No one ever said those studies were wrong. Not on a scientific level. No one has ever proved that they were a fraud. What they said essentially was you didn't get approval.

Therefore, we're going to erase what you've discovered here and now. We're talking over 20 years it's been of children, I believe, you know, be diagnosed with autism after being injured by a vaccine. I know ultimately we're going to win this fluoride battle. I hope this then you know, it's time to appeal this. Obviously, I guess, and go to the Supreme Court and see if they too, don't care what's happening to the IQs of our future generations in the United States of America.

That public momentum then goes into political action and legal actions. And here we go. So we have to break these down. But in the court of public opinion, Maha and the spirit of Maha is winning. It's these political actions and the judge's actions and these Ninth Circuit's and things like this that are overturning this on what appear to be, again, really, really flimsy grounds, not really thought out analysis. So let's talk about the political piece on this. We have former Congressman Tim Ryan, and he wrote an op ed two years ago. It's kind of evergreen now. And it really came to fruition. He says this in Newsweek, "hey, Democrats, we should work with RFK Jr on fixing America's food system." Well, he's right on that. And chemicals and vaccines. But regardless of that, here's Tim Ryan recently on an interview. Listen to what he had to say.

I'm going to look at Patrick Soon-Shiong. He's an inventor, a surgeon, a scientist, a researcher, a cancer researcher. And he was on Tucker Carlson talking about cancer in a whole different way that the public may have never heard of before. Take a listen.

Your not imagining it. You win the battle and you lose the war. The reason you win the battle is because you see this little blip of a response with chemotherapy. And then the moment you stop or not, even you, you've actually now killed the cells that are there to protect you. You've upregulated the suppressor cells and you get metastases and you say, sorry, you now have to go to hospice. Think about that. That's what we've been doing for 50 years. That's a dogma that I'm fighting.

So he's not the first one to ever talk about this, but he is making a massive impact by simply stating it from a place of understanding and what he said there. Chemotherapy. It kills the actual cells T cells, natural killer cells that are your body's defense to fight cancer. So it's it's doing the opposite. It's the antithesis of trying to defeat cancer or rebalance the immune system. So the idea of starting to work with the immune system, understand it in a more natural, holistic way is, is moving through medicine and it's about it's about time. So I want to take that idea. I want to go into some of the developments, some studies that are coming forward now that that seem to be exciting. And to paint this idea, first of all, there's an entire there's an entire class of antibiotic resistant bugs. These are called superbugs. And two of the big ones here, this is a look at the headlines among superbugs MRSA. This is staph infections. This drug resistant staph infections is at the "forefront of antimicrobial resistance." That's a huge run. And then we have antimicrobial tuberculosis TB. And that counts for about 1 in 3 deaths from antimicrobial resistance. So the antibiotics are simply not working on these drugs. Medicine is out out of out of ammo. They have no way to fight these things. And it's killing a lot of people around the world. Well, some studies from Ireland have just come out and this is the Daily Mail. Reporting on this "turbocharging immune system could mean end of antibiotics."

So it says "lead researcher Dearbhla Murphy, an immunologist at Trinity College Dublin, told Good Health, quote, we when we had trained the cells, they were better able to kill tuberculosis and staph aureus bacteria." Staph infection. "Intriguingly," the Daily Mail writes, "people vaccinated against TB were less likely to die not just from TB but from other infections too. The Trinity team wanted to know whether they could replicate that protective effect without a vaccine." Here we go. Paradigm shift time. So we want the immune system to activate in a more natural way, with more natural components than putting an injection into somebody. So remember Patrick Soon-shiong in that clip we just saw, he said the current accepted cancer paradigm. It kills natural killer cells. It kills T cells. Well, there is something called interferons. It's a group of signaling proteins that activate those killer cells and those T cells. So this is what these researchers did in Ireland. This is the actual study here. So we're going to go into a little bit of the science. But I'll explain this. It says interferon gamma. That is again that's the signaling proteins that are the alarm system for the immune system. Interferon gamma induced trained immunity enhances killing of priority pathogens. That's the tuberculosis. That's the staph infections in healthy and genetically vulnerable individuals. So they write this the researchers. "In conclusion, we provide evidence to support the hypothesis that exposing human monocytes to interferon gamma induces trained immunity in macrophages." So just breaking this down, they trained the interferon gamma before they introduced it into the cells.

So it's almost like taking soldiers and putting them through boot camp and then putting them on the battlefield, as opposed to just putting people on the battlefield that's never seen battle before. So in the immune system gets these trained kind of instructions, they know exactly what to do. So it says that it trained immunity in macrophages. That's the clean up crew "by enhancing host responses to infection of tuberculosis and staph infection." "Moreover, a single exposure of interferon gamma to monocytes from genetically vulnerable people with sufficient to support macrophage immunity to these pathogens of concern. These data have important implications for the design of Immunosupportive host directed adjunctive therapy or preemptive Prophylactic Interventions in vulnerable or immunosuppressed hosts." So again paradigm shift here. They're targeting they're saying this could be used for for populations that are in the target of these or for immunosuppressed people. So right now we they're saying there's safe natural therapies designed specifically for those who have immunosuppression to this. Right now, what we're doing is blanketing entire populations with risky vaccines because of those few immunosuppressed people, risky vaccines that harm people because we're trying to protect a few immunosuppressed people. We're keeping kids out of school because of one immunosuppressed or two immunosuppressed children. This research flips that entire paradigm on its face. It's a massive it's a massive change. Now. It's not off the shelf. You can't buy these products yet, but this shows an idea of where researchers are going.

It does. I think what we're seeing here is that, you know, the word is out. People are starting to really question Vaccines. And as the industry seems to want to make everything a vaccine, when you have 60% of pregnant moms now in America saying, I'm going to skip vaccines, I'm going to go against the CDC schedule. Certainly smart scientists should start looking in other direction. Pretty good sign, by the way, where the study basically says, look, we know that a vaccine induces this, you know, type of protection, but could we get the immune system to respond without a vaccine? And then they go out and do it? Doesn't even seem like that study would have seen the light of day or been funded in any way ten years ago. I really do think we are now in a in a beautiful new world, or at least, you know, the beginnings of one.

Yeah. At the beginnings for sure. Let's finish off with cancer. Just last month, we reported, uh, researchers out of Japan been working on this for years. They found that the gut microbiota in amphibians, um, they actually found one of the gut microbiota. It's *Ewingella americana*. It's a new therapeutic agent that has cytotoxic and immunomodulatory properties, which means basically it can kill cancer and it can up level the immune system against cancerous tumors. And it was very effective at that. Well, moving on that research, looking to the natural environment for for cancer, you know, I'll say the word cures, but something that can help the human race with cancer. We have this headline out of UCLA "research expands on using bee venom to treat cancer." And this really started in a big way in 2020 with this research. This is very extensive research here. "Honeybee venom and melittin suppresses growth factor receptor activation of high enriched and triple negative breast cancer." Melittin is is the actual protein of bee venom the actual component? And the researchers say this. "Here we demonstrate that honeybee venom and its major component melittin potentially induced cell death, particularly in the aggressive triple negative and Her2 enriched breast cancer subtypes." Again, no answer to these. We're looking at bee venom. That might be an answer. "Honeybee venom and melittin suppress the activation of EGFR and HR by interfering with the phosphorylation of these receptors in the plasma membrane of breast cancer carcinoma cells." So we look at one of the images here from this actual study. And these are the if you look at this, the the blue line and the red line, it's titled Skbr3. And some. 159 these are human breast cancer cell lines. And you can see at the top here, honeybee venom treated them and Melittin treated them.

And you look at the bottom. That's the timeline. Not 60 months, not 60 days or 60 weeks, 60 minutes in 60 minutes after treatment, you see a massive degradation of cell viability in these human breast cancer cells. Again, tabletop exercises. You can't buy this stuff off the shelf. Your doctor is not going to prescribe these, but this is massive. No current treatment shows any of this right now that's being given not chemotherapy. Nothing. So again and these researchers go on to say this in the article. In their research they conclude with this "honeybee venom is available globally and offers cost effective and easily accessible treatment options." So they're they're acknowledging the how much it costs for the current chemotherapy. And so it's "accessible treatment options in remote or less developed regions." "Further research will be required to assess whether the venom of some genotypes of bees has more specific or potent anti-cancer activities, which could be exploited, then be exploited." So, my God, I mean, talk about thinking outside the box. And now at this point, 2026, there's already meta analysis, systemic reviews of all the data because there's so much data piling in here. Here's one of them, a potential game changer. Melittin. That's that protein from the bee venom. "Potential game changer in the fight against breast cancer" um this is this is really, really good news. And it's showing that research and medicine is thinking outside the box in a big way and understanding that after 50 years of a non holistic approach, they're going back to a centered, balanced approach to treat the entire body as it stands with the immune system. We'll report on this more. But this is great momentum.

We have to look at Italy, look at the headlines in Italy and what they show us about the health of people and the largest percentage that are dying of Covid 19. 99% of those who died from the virus had other illness. It's gone a step further. "Why have so many coronavirus patients died in Italy?" "The country's high death toll is due to an aging population, overstretched health system and the way fatalities are reported, only 12% of death certificates have shown a direct causality from coronavirus, while 88% of patients who have died have at least one pre morbidity, many had 2 or 3." This is excess deaths. This is deaths that either goes above the average line or below it. We are below the top line. Okay. This is what has the entire world terrorized.

Well, it was really amazing. We landed in Milan and immediately raced to our first screening of An Inconvenient Study. And there at the theater, we were able to meet with some of the local scientists, doctors, and journalists that found themselves in in that epicenter dealing with the Covid outbreak. And it was a very enlightening experience. I have to say, for me and my camera crew. We were all mind blown at, uh, you know what we're hearing? What we're seeing. The first interview I want to bring your attention to is the first interview I ended up doing with Alberto Contri. He was a former president of Puebla de Progreso and former RAI board member RAI being one of the biggest media companies in Italy. This was a media man, he said. His expertise was actually media advertising and pharmaceutical. So he was well aware of science and where media collide had tons of friends and political, uh, people that he knew when all of this was going on. And he really had a perspective that actually blew my mind.

Alberto, thank you for joining me today.

The vaccine took one year really in the pandemic here. We were under the impression that many, many people were dying in Italy, that it was higher death rates than we had ever seen. Were there higher death rates when you since you knew doctors and you knew experts. Did they think they were seeing a real pandemic, or was it just being heightened by media exaggeration?

That's why even if they had three, four pathologies, they wrote that down.

So our question was, were we manufacturing deaths, um, through our hospital systems? How do you explain doctors going along with that decision? Was it just money where doctors getting paid to up the bill, or were they forced.

So every doctor who generally makes 3 to 4000 per month was making 20,000, so a big difference. Other doctors were convinced because we have these so-called viral stars, these virologists on TV, who were paid by pharmaceutical companies to make a massive propaganda. So much so that the population split in two. Well, let's say not exactly two, because 80% of the population was totally in favor and believed in science, and 20% was against, but had no possibility of speaking because they were crushed down and marginalized and suspended for refusing. If it's an outbreak, whatever we want to call it, the moment this pandemic starts, it starts in Italy, China, kind of like, oh, there's something happening there. But Italy is where this explodes. And how could it possibly be that the officials in Italy just, just on their own, decided, you know, what we should do right now? We should make this look worse than it looks by incentivizing it to be diagnosed as Covid. It goes against logic, actually. No country wants to look like they're having an outbreak or an unable to control it. So why would you incentivize it to look like it's even bigger than it is? Why would you line up vehicles and say they're filled with dead bodies? You're going to make you're going to destroy your own tourism. That explosion was caused by the fact that they had to make up the fact of there being so many deaths, but this was totally made up.

How did they make it up? How did they do that?

On national TV. They started to send images and pictures and videos of many people. But these were not from Covid. These were immigrants that came in the south of Italy, and they were probably naturally dead. They were screening on TVs, all these images of those people, but they were not from Covid. And especially they made up the numbers of infected people, according to the nose swab that they did. Those tests were totally incorrect, so they instead used those to spike up the numbers. When you look at those numbers, is that represented in the deaths of Covid? Was it was this virus as deadly as we were being told?

We had a huge concentration of deaths in the northern area, especially Bergamo, Brescia and other towns. And almost nothing in the other in the other parts of Italy. Because when this when they when the government say that they were going to lock down everyone, many, many immigrants, Italian immigrants from the South were living to the north, decided to rush down to the south to avoid the lockdown. So a huge amount of people went from north to south trains, cars, airplanes, and so on. And for some magical reasons, they the contagion. The virus didn't migrate south. So we had not an explosion of the Covid illness in the South. So it's really it's really something that has to be investigated. But it's not my field. I'm not an epidemiologist.

You know, the numbers aren't adding up. Some real revelations there by train. First of all, one of the things I was questioning, did anything happen in the North at all? They saw very high rates of death in that area. He has the mortality data to prove it. So was that just about inflating numbers? Well, I ran into a doctor, um, that believes he does know what happened in Bergamo. Doctor Pietro Gasparoni, you're about to hear the first time I've ever heard this information. It was a pretty mind blowing moment. Take a look at this. My next guest is Doctor Pietro Gasparoni. And my understanding is you've had a lot of experience treating Covid vaccine injury. And since they were young, uh, people got scared and they did this mass vaccination of meningitis combined with the flu vaccine, normal flu vaccine. And so 400 000 people received this vaccine between January and February 2020 where we had the Covid explosion. So it was during those two weeks where the immune system of all these people was low, that the Covid infection, uh, came in easily compared to other regions.

The region and the local health authority have already established an emergency sanitary cordon to vaccinate the population and determine the cause of the infection. But public fear is growing." There it is. Panic. We have a vaccine. Everybody get out and get this meningitis vaccine right away. We see this happen. And then, of course, we do see the media talking about this meningitis, panic queues and crowds at the local health authority for vaccinations. Vaccination will also be available on Sunday and Monday. The population is concerned after four cases in recent days. Look at that date January 4th 2020. Queues and crowds this morning as the eight and a municipality in the province of Bergamo, overlooking Lake Iseo to get vaccinated against Meningococcus C following the four cases of meningitis with two deaths detected in the last month in the lower Sabino area of the population was literally gripped by panic.

Folks. That is a barn burning revelation right there. We have actually discussed some of these details using world data with our team, but I've never seen it as clearly stated as that. First of all, he says, we have a problem. We have a real problem with this mortality data. The death rate is higher in 2022, when this thing is supposed to be over and you know Covid is going down, the death rate is higher than it is in 2021, and 2021 is higher than 2020. When we're supposed to believe this entire thing broke loose and bergamot and everything got crazy. And it was the worst part of the pandemic. When did you first start seeing a rise in myocarditis pericarditis during Covid?

At the beginning of 2021, between December and March, I started to see the first myocarditis. Some of them manifested soon, others manifested much later. In 40% of cases, we can find some symptoms of a previous myocarditis, even 1 or 2 years after the manifestation. Magnetics can find a late gadolinium enhancement. This is a scale of myocardium and is an electric, unstable area of the myocardium, which can generate fatal arrhythmias.

Myocarditis is not mild. There's a new classification. There is These are never, never existed. My my God, my God. Dad is an acute, uh, damage of the myocardium. This can last for even for years. I have a patient with myocarditis at a four after four years of vaccination.
